Great news for the community! The City of Federal Way proudly announces that we have successfully acquired \$120,800 for pedestrian improvements along Pacific Highway near Federal Way High School.

Mayor Ferrell received the confirmation letter in March from the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB). As mentioned in the letter from TIB's Executive Director, the project is supported by funding from Washington's Climate Commitment Act (CCA).



SHOWING SUPPORT FOR THE MARINERS BY LIGHTING UP OUR PAEC BLUE BEFORE THEIR HOME OPENER!



It also teaches the skills and organizational structure to respond to the immediate needs of the community, supporting First Responders in the event of an emergency or disaster.

<u>Training is Free</u> – Upon graduation, each student volunteer receives their own backpack with CERT gear and a certificate of completion.
