**Repairs are underway! A **certified and licensed** structural engineer **confirmed** that the supporting **I-beams and infrastructure are safe and secure**.

The goal is to ensure that the structure lasts for **another 60+ years**. We anticipate a **completion date of May 2025**. The total cost of this project is **\$2.3 million**.





Thank you to Julia Schneider, Business Operations Manager at the Seattle Children's South Clinic and its staff, for arranging a tour last week with our City Council President Linda Kochmar, Councilmembers Susan Honda and Jack Walsh, Tanja Carter (Economic Development Director), Kim Bachrach (Human Services Coordinator), and other City of Federal Way staff! 




