Mayor Ferrell recently went on a tour with our **Parks & Recreation Department** to examine the rust and corrosion damage in the locker room area at our **Federal Way Community Center**. A **certified and licensed** structural engineer **confirmed** that the supporting I-beams and infrastructure are **safe and secure**.

The goal is to ensure that the structure lasts for **another 60+ years**. We anticipate a **completion date of May 2025**. The total cost of this project is **\$2.3 million**.

Seadrumar Recycling is shredding paper and sensitive documents for recycling on-site.

Shred up to three shopping bags of paper. No pre-shredded paper.



EXPANDED POLYSTYRENE FOAM

Styro Recycle is collecting expanded polystyrene foam for recycling.

Only clean and dry #6 expanded polystyrene containers and blocks white in color, packing peanuts (any color). No tape or labels, no hot tub covers



TEXTILES

Goodwill is collecting new and used clothing, towels, bedding, fabric, and rags.

If items are not suitable for resale, please label them "threadcycle" for proper recycling.



SMALL HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES AND ELECTRONICS

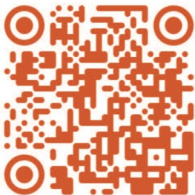
