# ACTIVE THREAT TRAINING A PRIORITY FOR OUR POLICE DEPARTMENT

Federal Way Police Department trains officers on a variety of different topics, tactics, and procedures. However, the most important training topic is officer response to saving lives during an active-threat event, to ensure public safety.



Active-threat incidents have unfortunately become all too common in recent years, occurring in various settings such as schools, workplaces, and public spaces. In these high-stress situations, every second counts, and the actions taken by law enforcement can mean the difference between life and death. Active-threat training provides officers with the skills and mindset needed to swiftly and decisively confront such threats, minimizing casualties and neutralizing the danger.

One of the key benefits of active-threat training is its emphasis on rapid response and dynamic decision-making. Officers are trained to enter the scene quickly, locate the threat, and engage the assailant with the goal of stopping the violence as soon as possible. This proactive approach contrasts with traditional tactics that may have involved waiting for specialized units like SWAT to arrive, potentially allowing the situation to escalate unchecked.

Importantly, active-threat training is not just about reacting to threats but is also about prevention and preparedness. Officers are trained to recognize warning signs and potential indicators of violence, allowing them to intervene early and prevent tragedies before they occur. Additionally, regular training exercises and drills ensure that officers are well-prepared to handle various scenarios and adapt to changing circumstances effectively.



Although active-shooter response training starts in the classroom with generalized concepts, most of the training takes place through reality-based scenarios where officers practice responding to these situations. When officers practice their responses in controlled scenarios, it leads to smoother response during actual emergency situations. The Federal Way Police Department conducts this training annually, but we also work with the Valley SWAT team that hosts monthly training sessions for groups of officers from the Valley Cities and our federal law enforcement partners.






