# SEA-TAC AIRPORT EXPANSION PUBLIC COMMENT MEETING



On Tuesday, November 12, Mayor Ferrell attended the public comment meeting at Wildwood Elementary on the proposed SEA-TAC Airport Expansion. Mayor Ferrell is grateful to the Port of Seattle and the FAA for scheduling this feedback meeting in our City. This public meeting is the beginning of outreach by the Port about the proposed airport expansion that will continue into late 2025. It is essential that our residents be fully involved and have a voice in this public comment process.

The proposal includes 31 projects including a new passenger terminal, 19 gates, and additional cargo facilities. These projects are proposed due to a projected increase in annual passengers handled by the airport growing from 46.9 million in 2017 to 56 million in 2027, and further increasing to 66 million by 2034.

# CRIME PREVENTION 101: STAYING SAFE AND SECURE AS A SENIOR

The Federal Way senior community recently gathered at the Federal Way Community Center for Staying Safe and Secure as a Senior – Crime Prevention 101.

With support from Steel Lake Presbyterian Church and the Senior Advisory Council, attendees enjoyed a free lunch while learning essential crime prevention strategies.

Tiffany Clemmings, the Community Engagement Coordinator for the Federal Way Police Department, presented detailed information on topics like situational awareness, auto theft prevention, home safety, scam identification, and the importance of reporting crimes.

One of the most engaging segments focused on scams, including the use of Artificial Intelligence to mimic the voices of loved ones in fraudulent attempts to request money or payments.

As a reminder, the Federal Way Police Department or any reputable agency will never request money or donations over the phone.

Avoid sharing personal or financial information over the phone unless you can independently confirm the caller's identity.






# **ONLINE GARDENING CLASS**
